## *First Things*

### **Connection... with Commitment**

One clear characteristic of the First Congregational Church of River Edge is our valuing of one another in our community. There is an obvious loving awareness of one another and an interest in each other's lives. Yet sometimes—in the rush of life—people and needs get missed; we don't follow up on our relationships the way we wish. We lose track of things; we risk losing track of one another!

A number of FCC folks have seen that potential gap, and they have voiced their desire to "mind the gap." Thus, in the past month, they have come together to form our Care Ministry—a committed ministry of connection and visitation with one another. Currently there are six care givers, coordinated by Terrie Clark, who will seek to keep regular contact with people of the congregation who might be homebound, who might be in a time of need, or who might value a personal connection.

To some, the concept may sound familiar. Not so many years ago we were engaged in Stephens Ministry, a highly formalized system of care, with intense training and intensely involved relationships. This new care ministry may share some of the same core concepts, but is much more informal.

Our goal is to seek to nurture natural relationships as brothers and sisters in the body of Christ. That, quite simply means to "rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. Live in harmony with one another." (Romans 12:15-16)

Our new Care Ministry helps us to be just what the church is supposed to be. Their visits will offer care, a listening ear, and the opportunity to pray together. I will be blessed by the support The Care Ministry gives to our pastoral care. I often feel that I'm not able to get to enough people often enough. This sharing among more members of the body of Christ will allow me to focus more effectively on critical needs and emergency pastoral care, as well as ongoing needs.

Already, the Ministry is out there among you offering care. And I have personally experienced the gift of the Care Team, in the midst of my frustrations with my newly-broken hand (now if I could just get them to type for me!)

The Care Team has committed to gathering regularly to (confidentially) coordinate contacts and to hone the gifts of listening and caring. Should you wish a visiting relationship for yourself, or for a need of which you are aware, please contact the church office, Terrie Clark, or me.

### Summer Programming

### New Church School Curriculum

The Education Team has settled on a new church school curriculum for the 2018-2019 church school year. After much research, we have chosen a curriculum that best suits our children currently enrolled in our church school program. It concentrates on the full biblical narrative and focuses on building a lasting foundation of faith and Bible engagement.

**Ages 3-5yrs** will be using the **Frolic Preschool** curriculum. This program offers both Old and New Testament lessons and spreads one lesson over 2 weeks in order to give the children more time to explore the stories.

**Grades 1-6** will be using the **SPARK All Kids** program with lessons that are intentionally designed for children ages 6-11 to learn together in one classroom. This gives them the opportunity to explore the Bible stories while the older children can lead the younger ones in buddy activities and relationship building moments.

Parent information sessions will be held in August and September to help familiarize them with the new program, so look out for those dates. In the meantime, feel free to check out some samples at [www.wearesparkhouse.org](http://www.wearesparkhouse.org).

**Grades 7-8** will be participating in a Pre-Confirmation program which will include worship time and involvement, community service, youth group participation and assisting with church school classes. More details to follow.

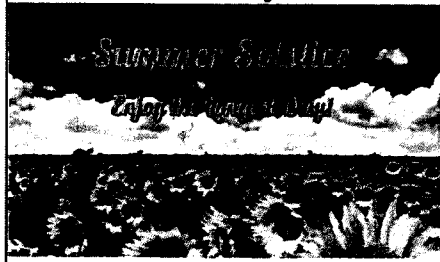

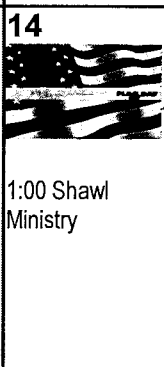
